

The **Austin Astronomical Society (AAS)** is a club for people who are interested in any aspect of astronomy or the space sciences. We meet monthly on the second Friday of each month. Through informal ties with the University of Texas Astronomy Department, our primary meeting site is on the UT Austin campus. We invite you to attend one of our meetings. The Society's **Eagle Eye Observatory (EEO)** is located at Canyon of the Eagles Lodge & Nature Park (COE) which is on the upper branch of Lake Buchanan, northwest of Burnet, Texas.

The Eagle Eye Observatory houses the 16-inch Ealing Educator Telescope, a research-grade Cassegrain telescope; and the Society's original telescope, the 12.5-inch Harlan Smith, a Newtonian. Surrounding the observatory building is a large scenic observing field with 30 powered tables for AAS members to set up their observing equipment.

The AAS holds regularly scheduled observing sessions or **star parties**, for the public and for AAS members only, at the EEO. Additionally, the AAS sponsors several major astronomy events each year. Two weekend-long star parties are held at Canyon of the Eagles Lodge & Nature Park, CenTex Astronomy Weekend, and the Central Texas Star Party (CTSP). Another major event, Austin Under the Stars, is hosted by St. Stephen's Episcopal School, in Austin, one or more times annually.

AAS membership is open to all. Individuals become eligible for Senior AAS Membership at age 65. Youth are eligible for junior AAS Membership until age 18.
